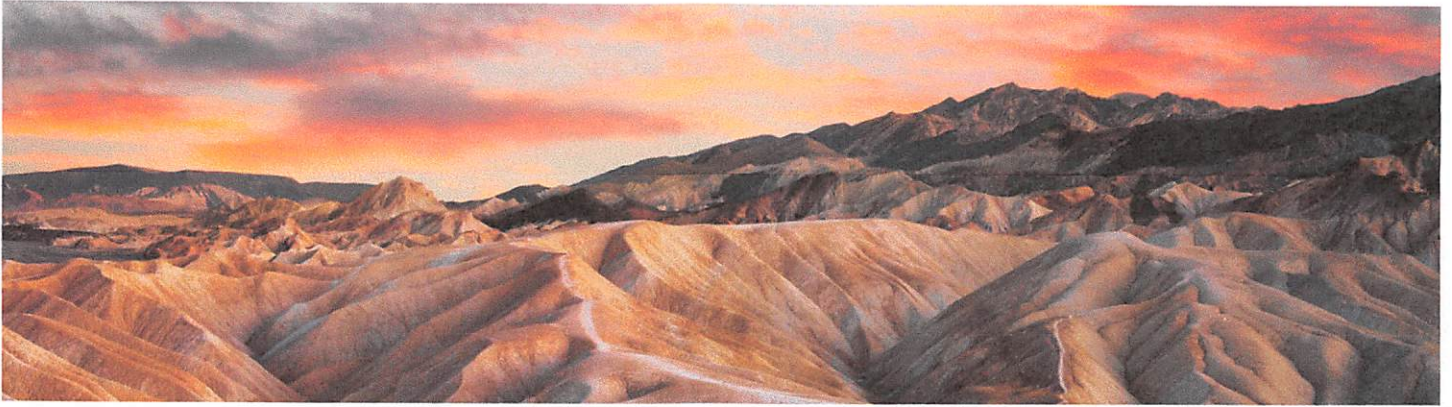

6th Annual Aaron Huisman Desert Art Contest

Welcome to the 6th Annual Aaron Huisman Desert Art Contest.

Artists are to check in with the room coordinator at the master table.

The judging will be done by 3 independent judges from the Nevada Art Council in Las Vegas. **Awards will be announced on Saturday October 28, 2023, at 3:45pm. on the Upper Stage in Cottonwood Park.** All artists are encouraged to be there.

Artists are responsible for the display, set-up and take down of their artwork. The room coordinator shall designate the table for each category and age group. Any display items required are the responsibility of the artist. Artwork may be hung on the walls on **Existing** hooks only. In the areas designated for each age group. **No holes will be made for hanging/displays.**

Winning artists will bring their Ribbons back to the Community Center to be displayed on their artwork until picked up at the end of the show. No artwork is to be removed before the end of the show without authorization and signing out by the coordinator.

Artists may pick up their artwork between 1:00 and 2:30pm on Sunday October 29, 2023. They must sign the log sheet that they have taken their piece(s). Any artwork left at the Beatty Museum will be taken to the Registration Booth for artists to pick up.

If artwork has not been picked up by the close of the Festival it will be taken to the Chamber of Commerce office at 119 E. Main St. and held for 60 days. After which time it will be disposed of at the Chamber Board of Director's discretion.

The Beatty Chamber of Commerce will have someone in the display room to oversee the artwork but is not responsible for any damage to artwork or display pieces that may occur during the time it is in the room.
